

# LIFETIME TRACEABILITY

All lambs must be supplied on an Atkins Ranch or PML ASD Form. Finishing lambs must have the Atkins Ranch antibiotic free status and 100% grass fed declaration from the farm of origin kept on file.



# THIRD PARTY VERIFIED

All producers must have on farm Quality Assurance to either the Atkins Ranch G.A.P Step 4 or Progressive Meats NZFAP certification.

# **MARKET OPTIONS**



OUR WHOLE FOODS MARKET PRODUCER GROUP IS FOCUSED ON SUPPLYING CHILLED LAMB TO OUR KEY CUSTOMERS IN THE USA. THE PRODUCER GROUP PROVIDES YOU WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO 'EFFECTIVELY' BECOME THE EXPORTER WITH ASSOCIATED OWNERSHIP, RISK AND MARGINS AND BE REWARDED WITH AN END OF SEASON MARKET RELATED POOL PAYMENT (SUBJECT TO PERFORMANCE). THE SUPPLY PERIOD FOR THE PRODUCER GROUP "POOL" IS FROM 3RD JANUARY 2022 THROUGH TO 30TH DECEMBER 2022.



THIS PROGRAMME IS FOCUSED ON SUPPLYING THE US RETAIL READY MARKET. FURTHER PROCESSING OF THIS PRODUCT OCCURS AT ATKINS RANCH FREMONT BEFORE RETAIL DISTRIBUTION. THESE LAMBS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE ATKINS RANCH G.A.P STEP 4 CERTIFIED.

# G.A.P STORE LAMB SUPPLY



As part of our G.A.P lamb supply into the USA market we need G.A.P store lamb producers to continue the G.A.P accreditation from birth, to our finishers, through to market. This option enables you to be part of the family without having to supply prime lambs to slaughter. If you want to receive direct market feedback about the product

you are producing and feel like you are involved in something bigger, this option could be for you. To assist our producers keeping store lambs in the family, we have developed a store lamb dashboard. This is a transparent listing platform for available and wanted G.A.P accredited ewes and lambs, sent out to the producer group twice a week. Talk to one of our livestock team to find out more.

# **\$** COMMITMENT BONUS

To be eligible for the commitment payment suppliers must commit lambs before the closing date(s) and supply at least the number committed. Payment will be weighted depending on supply week to reflect the annual supply curve. There is no Commitment Bonus paid on Mutton.

# **CONTACT & COMPLETION**

To be eligible for this payment, producers must confirm bookings by Wednesday evening of the week prior to delivery and deliver 85% or more of their confirmed number. Achieving this producers will be rewarded \$0.50 per head.

# **S**/ DRAFTING PAYMENT OPTIONS

We believe in full transparency between producers, agents and ourselves. In line with these beliefs we offer options to suit all producers' livestock drafting preferences.

Stock Agent - By electing your chosen stock agent to be your drafter they will be responsible for drafting livestock, booking and confirming livestock on time, and organising trucking to the plant once delivery time is confirmed by Progressive Meats Ltd. The agent will undertake all communication with yourself and the booking office, and will receive \$1.50 per head.

Own Agent – All functions undertaken by a stock agent are completed by the producer. These include booking and confirming livestock, drafting livestock (including milk lambs) and organising trucking to plant once delivery time is confirmed by Progressive Meats Ltd. Producer will receive \$1.50 per head. It is important to note this can be a demanding role. Producers will be expected to operate at the same standards that we expect of our agent partners.

**Self Drafter** – The producer may decide to draft their own stock but utilise their agent for logistics and time coordination. This function allows the producer to share this payment with their agent at \$0.75 cents per head each.

To be eligible for either of the Own Agent or Self Drafter options the producer must complete two drafts where at least 90% of the lambs are in specification for the relevant supply programme. Prior to changing your current arrangement we expect that you will have had a discussion with your respective agent. The option you select needs to be indicated on your commitment form and will be confirmed for the season (a producer cannot swap between options during the season).

# **COMMITMENT REVIEW**

There will be a mid-year review, which will be due on the 8th May 2022 and a final review for the season which is due on the 18th September 2022. Producers are able to review and increase their original committed tally at any point up until the final review on the 18th September 2022. At this point committed tallies are finalised for the season.

# **T** SPACE ALLOCATION

The preferential booking system will be based on the following criteria to allocate space during peak periods. The Best Producer rankings will be used in conjunction with this to ensure our best performing producers secure their slaughter space requirements.

Heavy Lambs Limited has a shareholding in Atkins Ranch and currently has shares available for suppliers to purchase. As a shareholder you get priority booking for peak season processing space and the shareholder dividend, when coupled with the Whole Foods Producer Group pool payment, makes the combined shareholder/supplier return very attractive.

# ELECTRONIC ANIMAL STATUS **DECLARATION** (eASD)

Progressive Meats has adopted the OSPRI eASD app on plant which improves efficiencies on farm and at plant level. It is now a requirement that all farmers use eASD when sending lambs to Atkins Ranch. Failure to use eASD, without prior arrangement, may result in a 5c/kg penalty.



## CUTTER GRADES

Cutters with minor carcass damage are not downgraded to the Out of Spec grade. These carcasses will be paid at the grade price into which they fall.



Suppliers pay for the transport of lambs to the plant and are paid a transport rebate on the kill sheet. This way the producer can utilise the carrier of their choice. Wherever possible loads will be co-ordinated for economic truck loads.



# MUTTON

Atkins Ranch is provided mutton space through our close working relationship with Te Kuiti Meat Processors. Mutton space is available through Te Kuiti Meat Processors commitment programme with a portion of this mutton processed by Progressive Meats in Hastings. Space is allocated using the preferential booking system (in conjunction with the best producer ranking).

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# OUR COMMITMENT TO THE ENVIRONMENT



IN 2019 ATKINS RANCH PARTNERED WITH SAVORY INSTITUTE, INVESTING TO BECOME A FRONTIER FOUNDER OF SAVORY'S LAND TO MARKET PROGRAM TO PROMOTE AND SUPPORT REGENERATIVE PRODUCTION OF LAMB MEAT AND BY PRODUCTS.

Atkins Ranch entered into an initial pilot phase by establishing a pilot group of 23 producers to be involved in undertaking Savory's Ecological Outcome Verification on farm (EOV). EOV measures the indicators of ecosystem functionality in order to ascertain the overall health of the land and grazing systems that support production of their lambs. The program takes real-world assessment of soil health and sequestered carbon, water infiltration rates, and biodiversity. By utilising Land to Market's Ecological Outcome Verification, Atkins Ranch is able to provide enhanced assurance to our consumers that they are eating verified regenerative lamb raised with the highest animal welfare and environmental standards.



IN 2021 ATKINS RANCH WAS AWARDED THE REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE COMMITMENT AWARD FROM WHOLE FOODS MARKET FOR OUR COMMITMENT TO HOLISTIC FARMING AND GRAZING MANAGEMENT PRACTICES THAT IMPROVE SOIL, ENHANCE BIODIVERSITY AND INCREASE CARBON CAPTURE.

# **IN SPEC AWARD**

This award is to celebrate an individual who is able to consistently draft lambs to our program specific carcass specification. It is awarded on the highest % of lambs drafted in spec over all lambs supplied in the 2022 season. It will be awarded to the drafter on farm i.e agent, farm manager, or shepherd. To be eligible for this award you must supply a minimum of 500 lambs over at least six months of the year.

# **DRESS OUT YIELD AWARD**

An award will be presented at the 2022 Producer of the Year awards dinner to the producer achieving the highest Dress Out Yield over their lambs supplied in the 2022 season. To be eligible for this award you must supply a minimum of 500 lambs over at least six months of the year.

# **CONDITIONS OF SLAUGHTER**

## **DELIVERY OF STOCK**

- All stock arriving at Progressive Meats must be accompanied with a pre-sent electronic ANIMAL STATUS DECLARATION form.
- Trucking delivery times must be adhered to.
   If a problem does occur we would appreciate
   if the plant is advised as soon as possible to
   minimise disruptions.
- Additional stock arriving over and above the number confirmed must have plant approval. Excess numbers that cannot be accommodated will be returned to the producer at their own cost.
- No stock with excessive dags, dirty bellies, muddy purse etc will be accepted for slaughter and will be returned to the producer at their own cost.
- Lambs that require more than one wash will be deducted \$1.50 per head.
- No lambs which have been treated for Johnes Disease will be accepted for slaughter.
- No horned animals will be accepted for slaughter.
- No merinos will be accepted for slaughter without prior approval.

## TRANSPORTATION OF STOCK

- Stock must be fit to travel and must not be lame. A sheep is deemed lame if the animal is not weight bearing on one or more limbs when moving or standing; or the animal has difficulty walking and holds its head below its backline almost continuously.
- Stock must be emptied out for a minimum of four hours prior to trucking or, depending on the season and feed conditions, the same time as required for penning up for shearing.
- Refer to the Fit for Transport App by MPI if you are unsure about transporting stock.

## **INFORMATION USE**

 The information you have supplied will be seen by others in an abridged form and used in the scheduling and planning of the daily slaughter requirements of the plant.
